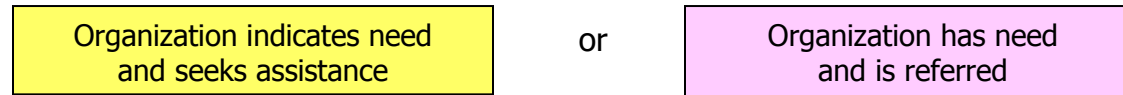


Organizational Capacity Leads to Community Impact

WNC Nonprofit Pathways is a collaboration of The Community Foundation of Western North Carolina, Cherokee Preservation Foundation, Mission Healthcare Foundation, and United Way of Asheville and Buncombe County. The program provides a range of training and support – developed with input from nonprofit leaders – to help community organizations become stronger and more successful. (See program components, below.) **Organizations are encouraged to access the “pathway” at the time and place that fits their needs. Once they begin, this is not a one-step process, but a multi-step effort by Staff and Board to pursue and complete organizational development goals.**

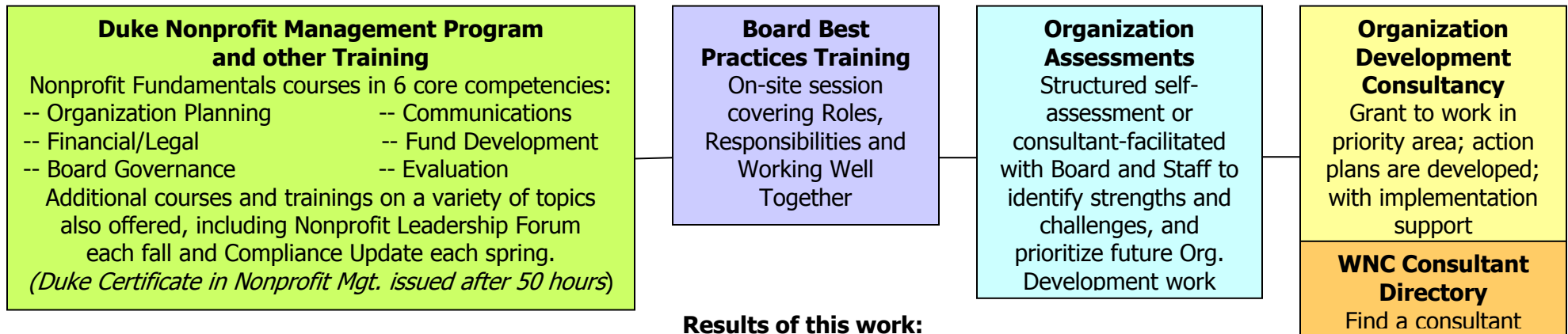
The process usually begins in one of two ways, either:
